#### LOCAL AREA ATTRACTIONS

#### Galle Face Green, Col 03.

Just beyond the hotel. Across the road from the hotel, lies the Galle Face Green, a hallmark of Colombo. This long stretch of lawn faces the sea in a stunning setting. At this popular rendezvous, look out for kite flyers and picnickers.

#### Colombo Fort, Col 01. Travel time - 05 minutes.

The Central Business District of Sri Lanka and its financial hub. Fort has held strong since the 16th century when the first colonisers, the Portuguese landed here.

Passing the Galle Face Green and driving toward Fort, you will see some of the finest colonial buildings depicting many different eras - the Old Parliament Building; the Dutch Hospital still retaining its age old charm even though now converted into a grand shopping precinct; the historical Cargills & Millers building and many more.

# Beira Lake, the Gangaramaya Temple & the Seema Malakaya, Col 02. Travel time -

Beira Lake is situated in the heart of the city. Surrounded by high rise buildings and bustling roadways, this lake is a picturesque oasis.

One of the most important temples in Sri Lanka, the Gangaramaya sits just a few yards away from the Beira lake. The temple's unique architecture blends elements of Sri Lanka, Thailand, India and China and is home to a collection of rare artefacts.

The Seema Malakaya was designed by world renowned Sri Lankan architect Geoffrey Bawa as an assembly hall for monks. It sits on floating platforms on the Beira Lake and is especially beautiful when illuminated at night.

#### Colombo National Museum, Col 07. Travel time - 10 minutes.

Housed in a historical building built in 1877, this museum tells the story of the great island of Sri Lanka through archaeological findings of the prehistoric period right through to the great Sri Lankan kingdoms. The museum's multiple galleries offer a vibrant walk through Sri Lanka's rich heritage.

### Viharamahadevi Park, Col 07. Travel time - 10 minutes.

The largest park in Colombo with a variety of remarkable plants and trees and impressive ponds. Over the weekends, budding artists showcase spectacular paintings, giving the adjoining roadway the affectionate name, "Art Street".

### Pettah, Col 11. Travel time - 10 minutes.

Pettah is a great bazaar bustling with life. Considered the trading centre of the city this maze of crisscrossed streets is filled with every variety of goods from textiles to spices. There is method to the madness of Pettah though - Main Street is where you will find saree & shalwar kameez shops whilst for gold and silver jewellery you'd visit the shimmering Sea Street. For mobile phones, go to Second Cross Street.

With tuk-tuks whizzing by and crowds right through the day, shopping in Pettah takes a skill of its own!

#### Independence Square, Col 07. Travel time - 15 minutes.

Built to mark the end of colonial rule by British, Independence Square depicts unique architecture with intricate carvings, a statue of D.S. Senanayake, the first prime minister of Sri Lanka and the Independence Memorial museum. Today with winding walkways and elaborate waterways, Independence Square is the city's hot spot for joggers.

#### Royal Colombo Golf Club, Col 08. Travel Time - 15 minutes.

Situated in the heart of the city this 96 acre extent of land is a sanctuary offering not just golfing but also a serene and tranquil environment. Founded over 120 years ago this is the second oldest Royal Golf Club outside the United Kingdom and also showcases an array of historic golf memorabilia in the club house.

### Red Mosque, Col 11. Travel time - 15 minutes.

Jami-Ul-Alfar Mosque or "Red Mosque" is most distinctive for its red and white striped exterior and is believed to be a landmark identified by sailors approaching the port since it was built in 1909. Easily one of the most striking buildings in Pettah, the mosque is considered an architectural monument drawing many worshippers and sight-seeing crowds too.

#### Wolvendaal Church, Col 11, Travel time - 20 minutes.

This church was built in 1749 by the Dutch at a time when only wilderness stood beyond its walls. To date the church is beautiful and historically important with such treasures as ornate Dutch furniture, intricately carved wooden pews and lecterns. The stone floor includes the elaborate tombstones of 5 Dutch Governors.

### **Sri Ponnambalawaneswaram Hindu Temple - 20 minutes**

A temple dedicated to the Hindu God Shiva, Sri Ponnambalawaneswaram Temple is considered a sacred site by Hindus as well as all other ethnic groups. With a rich history that dates back to 1905 and architectural grace that puts modern architects to shame, this landmark structure attracts devotees from all parts of the country.

### National Zoological Gardens, Dehiwala. Travel time - 30 minutes.

The National Zoological Gardens are a sprawling area that is home to many animal species from across the globe. Diversity is visible from a walk through the aquarium, aviary, reptile house, butterfly garden and much more. Elaborate landscaping makes the zoo all the more pleasant.

### Sri Jayawardenapure, Kotte the administrative capital & home to the Parliament of Sri Lanka. Travel time - 40 minutes.

Kotte, the administrative capital of Sri Lanka has much to offer for sightseeing. As Sri Lanka makes significant strides in once again becoming "Asia's Garden City", this is one of the prime areas to benefit from lush greenery stretching alongside winding waterways. With walking tracks lining the lake, boat rides, a model farm where one can view the cultivation of paddy and quaint eateries this place has a life of its own. Situated on an island surrounded by the waters of the beautiful Diyawanna Lake, the Parliament is a magnificent structure designed by Sri Lankan architect Geoffrey Bawa who is world renowned for his ability to blend distinct buildings with their natural surroundings.

#### AREA ATTRACTIONS

### Mt Lavinia beach, Mount Lavinia. Travel time - 45 minutes.

Mount Lavinia offers a guick glimpse into Sri lanka's fun & guirky "beach life".

#### **Kelani Temple, Kelaniya. Travel time - 45 minutes**

Situated on the banks of the Kelani River, it is believed that the Lord Buddha preached at this site. The temple itself dates back over 2000 years and is even today a pocket of tranquility.

#### **COUNTRY ATTRACTIONS**

### **Adam's Peak**

Revered as a holy site by Buddhists, Hindus, Muslims and Christians, Adam's Peak rises dominantly above all other mountains in the vicinity creating a remarkable sight. A depression in the rocky summit resembles a huge footprint and this is the focus of all pilgrims. The climb to the summit gives you spectacular views from where sunrise is most beautiful.

#### Anuradhapura

The capital city of Sri Lanka from 4th century BC to 11th century AD. Today Anuradhapura is a UNESCO World Heritage site marked for its well preserved ruins of an ancient civilization. Multiple monasteries and temples, the "Sri Maha Bodhi Tree" which is believed to have grown from a branch of the very Bo tree the Lord Buddha gained enlightenment under, brilliant irrigation systems and recreational ponds all stand to showcase this historical glory.

### **Arugam bay**

This is where surfers from beginners to pros find the perfect waves. In addition to being one of the world's finest surfing points, this quaint and quirky town offers a leisurely pace of life adding to its allure.

#### **Dambulla**

The rock of Dambulla is the centre of a Buddhist cave-temple complex established in the 3rd century B.C. and has been in continuous use for over 22 centuries by Buddhist monks. Its rock temples are the most ancient and extensive in the Island and are also in the highest state of preservation.

### Galle

The seaside city of Galle dates back to the sixteenth century and stood accumulating its rich culture through the colonial periods of the Portuguese, Dutch and British. Today Galle is an archaeological treasure trove. The ancient Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage site, winds its way in a great circuit and is one of the most pleasant strolls by evening. The Dutch Reformed Church is the oldest of the many churches and was originally built in 1640. Its floor is paved with gravestones from the old Dutch cemetery and also houses an impressive pulpit. Galle is a wonderful sea-town to spend a day or two amidst chilled out cafes and restaurants as you brush with colonial charm.

### **Jaffna**

The waterscapes offered by the Jaffna lagoon are stunning with long stretches of secluded beach and bright orange sunsets. With a strong Hindu influence, there are many temples of intricate architectural design. Nallur in the mainland and Kagapoosani Kovil on the island of Nagadeepa are the most popular. Nagadeepa is also home to a Buddhist temple whose site at which it is believed that the Lord Buddha visited. Other sites such as the Jaffna fort and the famed Dutch Church date back to the colonial period.

#### **Kalpitiya**

The Kalpitiya peninsula is on the north-west coast of the island and is considered an unrivalled marine sanctuary with stunning bar reefs, flat coastal plains & mangrove swamps. Kalpitiva is an ideal location for dolphin & whale sightings as well as boat rides and snorkeling too.

#### Kandy

Known as the cultural capital of Sri Lanka, this scenic town is nestled in the hills and was a stronghold of the Sinhalese kings. Today the main site is the Temple of the Tooth relic which houses Sri Lanka's most important Buddhist relic - a tooth of the Lord Buddha.

The Kandy Perahara, an annual cultural pageant is one of the most colourful processions of the world with drummers, dancers and ornamented elephants performing on the streets of Kandy. Also visit the Peradeniya Gardens, a green paradise with exotic plants, flowers and rolling lawns.

#### Kitulgala

Surrounded by wooded hills, this rich riverine forest is a result of the Kelani River, meandering its way through. Sri Lanka's hot spot for white water rafting, Kitulgala is a key area for jungle trekking, mountain biking and bird watching too.

#### **Knuckles Mountain Range**

The range takes its name from a series of recumbent folds which resemble the knuckles of a clenched fist. With striking landscapes of mountain sceneries topped by mist, the forests of Knuckles also harbour a variety of many rare plant species. The mountains are a haven for trekking.

#### Negombo lagoon

Located on the west coast, Negombo lagoon is both scenic and borders a vibrant city. A traditional fishing village, this lifestyle is still evident with bright boats dotting the seas. The old Dutch fort with its fine gate and numerous historical churches make Negombo all the more alluring.

#### **Nuwara Eliya**

A city like no other with mist capped mountains, terraced tea gardens and charming bungalows. Situated in the hills of central Sri Lanka, this picturesque landscape is ideal for a quiet getaway.

### **Pasikuda**

On the east coast of the island with soft golden sand and pristine blue waves, the Bay of Pasikuda is a crescent-moon shaped inlet of shallow water and is one of the island's finest beaches for holidaymakers to just loll around in the sun or to take a swim in these calmer waters.

### **Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage**

A unique elephant orphanage, nursery and breeding ground for wild elephants, Pinnawela is remarkable for having the largest herd of captive elephants in the world. The main attractions are the opportunity to observe elephants bathing and playing from the river bank as well as being privy to the daily feeding and aspects of care.

#### **Sigiriva**

A UNESCO World Heritage site and considered the Eighth Wonder of the World, Sigiriya or 'The Lion's Rock' is an ancient rock fortress and palace built by King Kashyapa in 477 AD. Rising dominantly over the surrounding forest, Sigiriya is a phenomenal sight with an extensive network of reservoirs and ramparts and elaborately designed pleasure gardens. At the summit of the rock, remnants of a once stunning palace complex of great splendor still exist. Sigiriya is also renowned for its ancient frescoes depicting beautiful female figures in graceful contour.

### Sinharaja

A prime bio diversity location, this rain forest has gained international importance as a UNESCO World Heritage site. With an almost mysterious allure, two nature trails make for wonderful trekking with numerous streams and rivers.

#### **Trincomalee**

Situated on the east coast and home to some of the island's finest beaches, Trincomalee draws crowds for whale-watching, kite surfing and diving. The seven hot springs of Kanniya are also a major tourist attraction.

### **Wasgamuwa National Park**

With incredibly diverse wildlife, this park is home to 23 species of mammal including a majestic herd of over 150 elephants and the shy sloth bear that once lived in abundance in these forests. A haven for bird lovers, over 143 species of both endemic and migrant birds can be spotted. Being isolated by large rivers on all but its southern side, the Park supports varied vegetation making it breathtakingly beautiful especially at sunset.

#### **Wilpattu National Park**

Sri Lanka's largest national park, Wilpattu lies along the north-west coast. The Park derives its name from the existence of multiple "Willus", water basins that fill with rainwater to create a unique terrain surrounded by grassy plains. Wilpattu is one of the top National Parks world renowned for leopard sightings. Sloth bear, elephants, mugger crocodile, spotted deer and many more can be seen too.

### Yala

Yala National Park is Sri Lanka's most visited park with a beautiful coastline boundary. The Park finds its significant representation with wildlife enthusiasts for having one of the world's highest densities of leopard and frequent sightings of elephant too. The rock temple of Sithulpahuwa with a history of over 2200 years once housed thousands of monks who lived a life of solitude. Its scenic surroundings would still quiet the mind.
